Wicklewood is a popular village with a variety of its own employment, plus is close to Wymondham (just 2 miles) and Norwich (just 10 miles) and the A11 (just 2 miles) so makes a good base for busy families and commuting couples. We are aware from local estate agents that Wicklewood is a sought after village, as a 'Wymondham Village'. The village has a good primary school and from this site parents can walk to school safely. Possibly event via a new shortcut path to be made through the site and the adjoining village playing field. The village also has a regular bus service so those without a car can get to work and school. The village has a public house which is within easy walking distance of the site.
