6. Crossing required to access Co-op (nearest shops), note roadside footpath begins to narrow



5. Crossing over Hardingham Road required to Town Centre/Shops



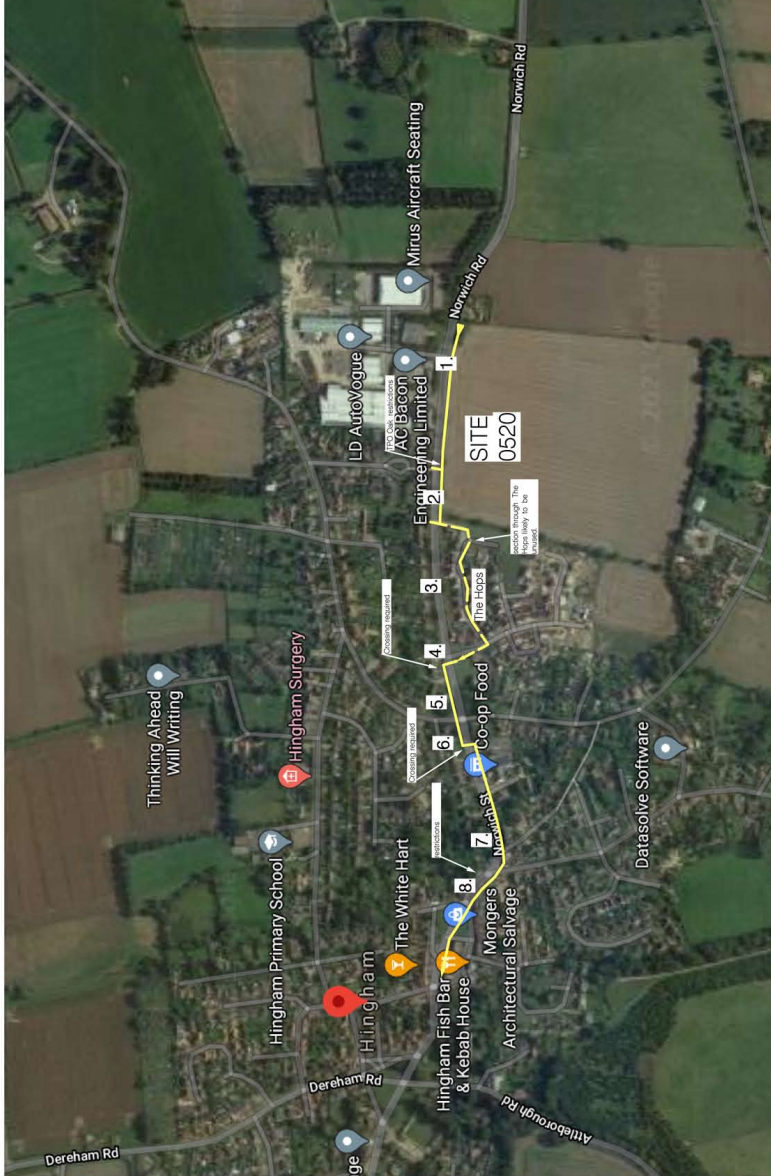
4. Mission approved as part of The Hops includes crossing island and local road widening. Relied upon for site 0520 route although pedestrians likely to use shortest route and have already crossed to the path on the Northern side.



3. Missing Section, Roadside footpath and active footage not able to be provided with previous development at the Hops due to future presence of TPO trees and historic hedgerow.



7. Narrow bends with severely restricted footpath on both sides, note leeward wall hazard likely to lead to pedestrians walking in the carriageway, 2nd crossing of carriageway required plus further crossing over Hall Lane.

1. Site 0520 footage unable to provide roadside footpath due to TPO Oak trees, note trees will also restrict potential access, visibility/widthening onto B1108 active footage/also not possible, potential crossing required.



8. Narrow bends with severely restricted footpath on both sides, path is blocked by taller buildings requiring crossing with poor visibility around bends

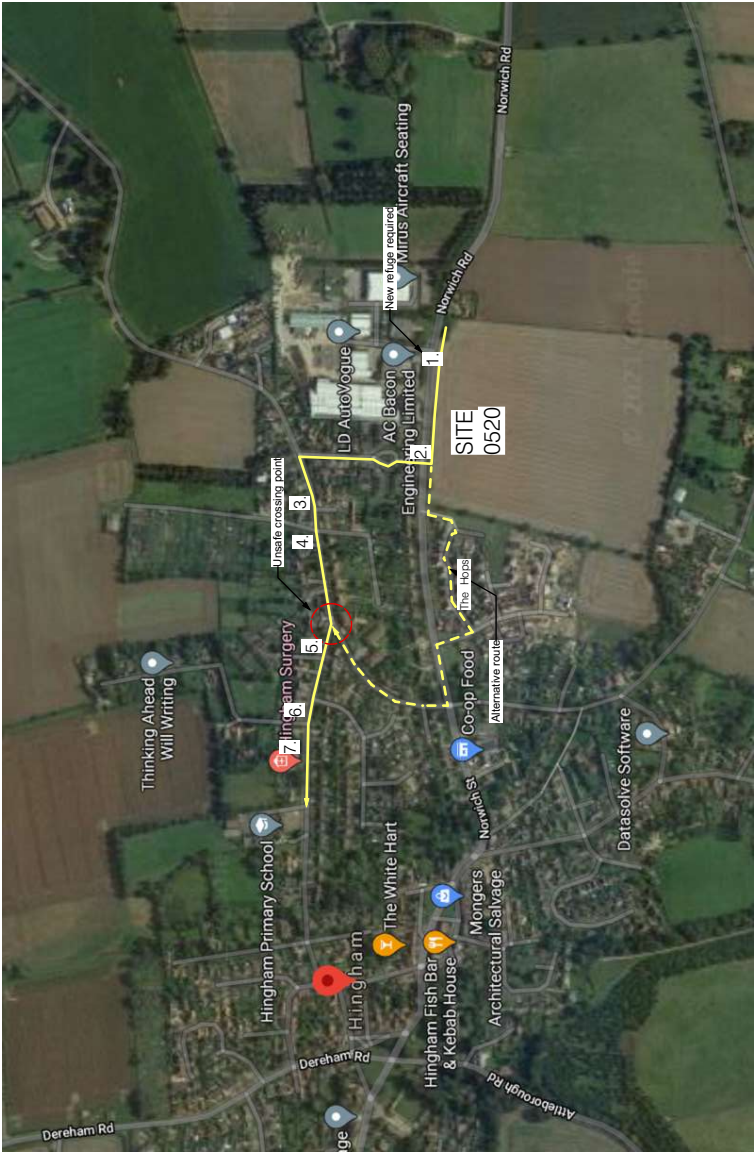
6 Crossing over Hingham Surgery entrance.

3 Roadside footprint crossing over Urish Glen.

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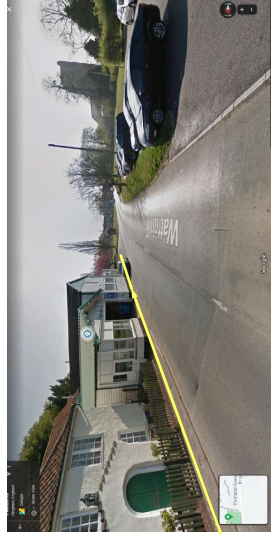

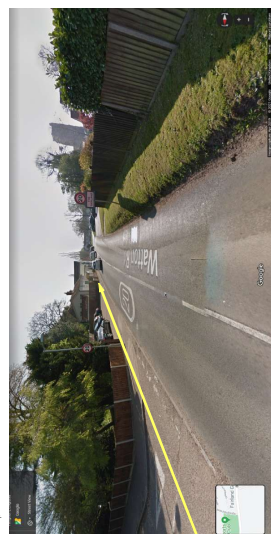

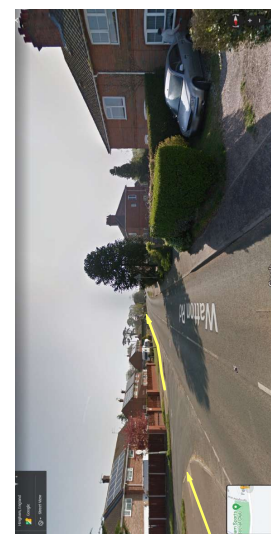

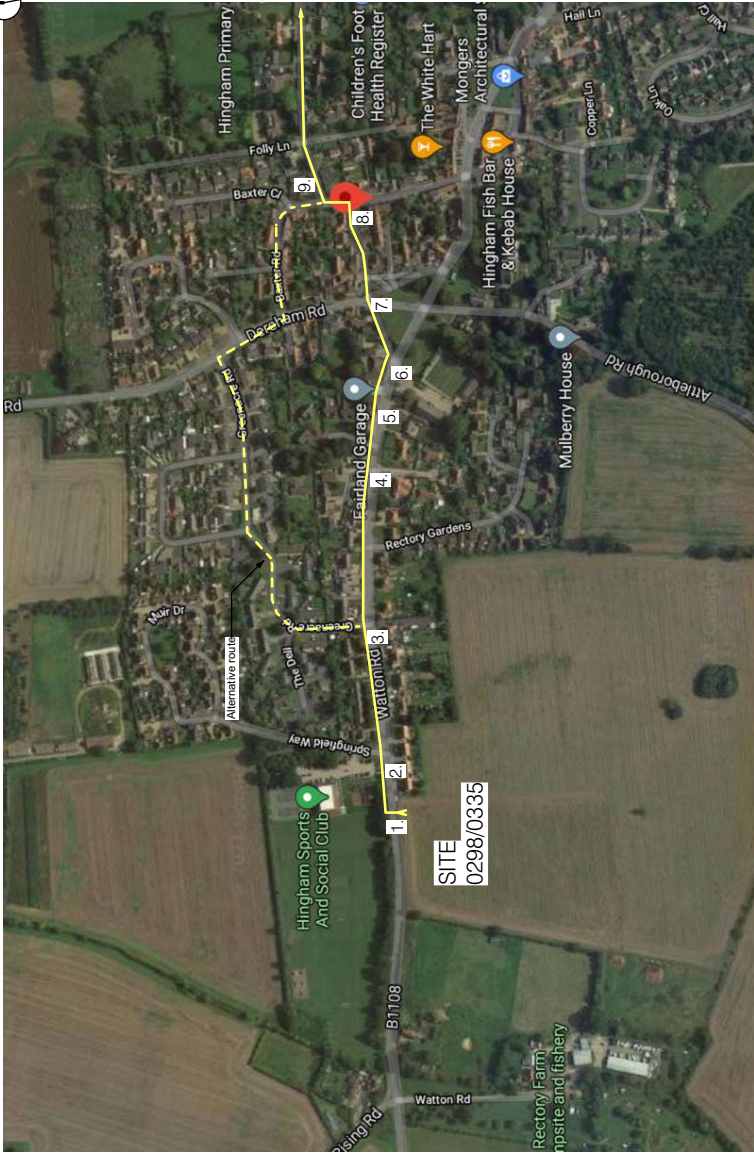

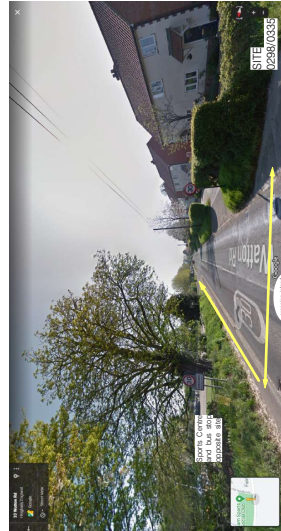

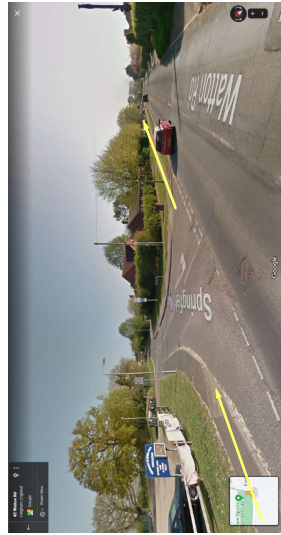

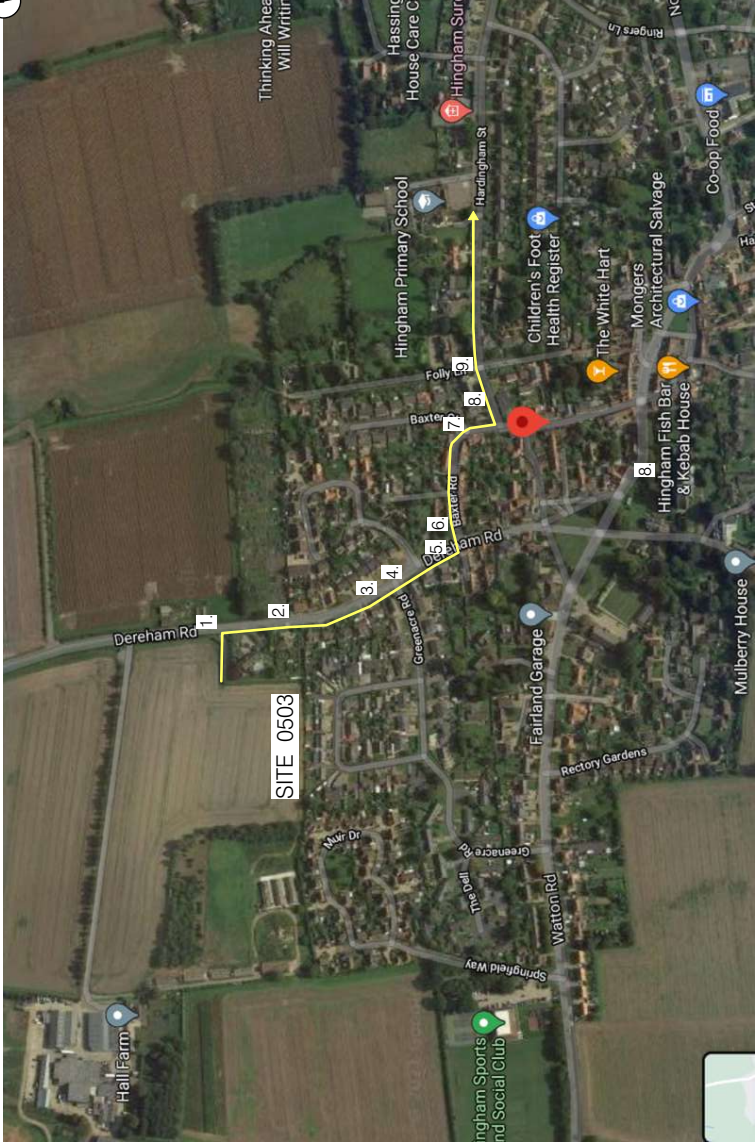

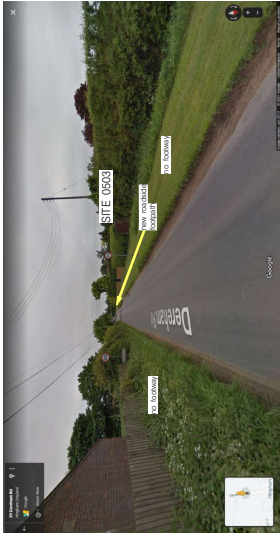

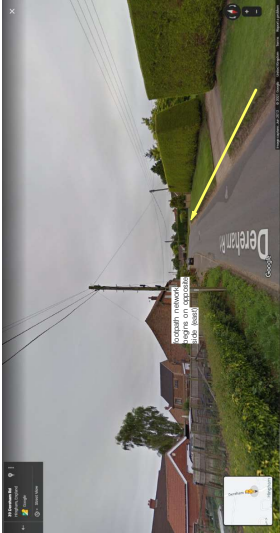
8. Herringham Street footpath. Narrow on northern side

1. Site 0503. No Footpath connections to site at present. New footpath required to western side of Dereham Road.



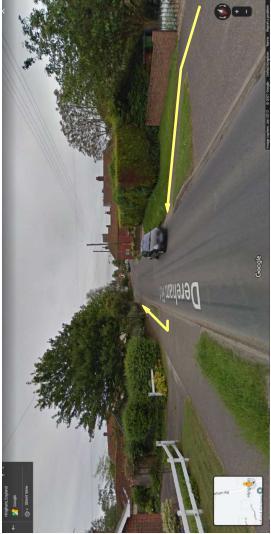

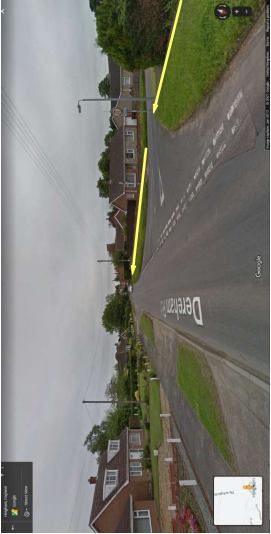
